

Château Tastin 2015

AOC PAUILLAC

The domain: Bought in 1901 to the Sir Gaudin, Château Tastin is a small family estate covering 2,5ha at Saint-Lambert, on the great Pauillac appellation. Grown with passion and know-how for 3 generations, the vineyard produce a powerful wine, typical of its exceptional terroir.

Annual production: 16 500 bottles.

Type of soil: Gravelly hilltop.

Grape varieties: 85 % Cabernet Sauvignon 15 % Merlot.

Crops and winemaking: The vineyard is carefully grown thorough the seasons to obtain the best fruits. At optimal maturity, the grapes are picked by hand and sorted out, then they are vinified for 30 days in cement and stainless steel vats.

Degree: 12,5°.

Tasting notes:

Appearance: Deep red color, almost black.

Bouquet: Expressive and intense with subtle violet and black currant flavors.

Palate: Strong attack followed by fruity notes.

Serving suggestions:

Serve around 17° and after one hour in a decanter before service. Château Tastin will pair well with stewed game, spicy dishes and grilled red meats in sauce. It will reach its best in a few more years.
