

## Location

The vineyard is exceptionally situated on the heights of Saint-Emilion. Surrounded by rocks, vines are sheltered from the wind and benefit from optimum sun exposure east-south-east.

#### Planted vineyard area

7.25 hectares.

Nature of soils Vines spread over asteria limestone plateau and on calcareous clay slope.

# **Plantation density**

Between 6,500 and 12,600 vines per hectare.

## Average age of vines

52 years (older vines, close to the Chapel, have more than 110 years).

## Harvest dates

Merlot : 23<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> of September. Cabernet Franc : 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> of September.

# Wine-growing and wine-making

Viticulture applying methods from organic agriculture. Beyond vines, meticulous care is given to global biodiversity. Traditional fermentation in wooden vats followed by 20 months ageing in French oak barrels (100% new).

#### 2017 Yield

35 hectoliters per hectare.

#### 2017 Blend

55% of Cabernet Franc and 45% of Merlot.
